# Why should Subawardees use the Participant Activity Survey (PAS-SUB)?

The PAS-SUB was reviewed by the Northwestern University IRB and determined to be “non-human subjects research.” Also, NLM Extramural Programs approved the survey for use.

## ➤ It's short, easy to complete, and inclusive.

On average, respondents will complete the online survey in less than five minutes. The survey and support materials are available in English and Spanish.

## ➤ It's ready for impact.

The PAS-SUB is designed to collect NNLM impact data in a standardized manner. This questionnaire is designed to provide you with data on your own accomplishments!

The PAS-SUB saves time: no need to worry about developing your own data collection plan! This is a comprehensive and succinct survey based on evaluation best practices.
